


Advent Devotionals



FIRST WEEK OF ADVENT—HOPE Scripture: Psalms 27: 14

Waiting is never easy, and Christmas is no different. Advent is a season of waiting and preparing, a good time to reflect on the importance of waiting and hoping in our lives. Light a candle or light one candle on the Advent Wreath. Ask everyone to share about some things they hope for in their lives. How does Jesus fit into these hopes?

Sing a Christmas Carol and close with prayer.



SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT - PEACE Scripture: Luke 2:13-14

Light a candle or light three candles on the Advent Wreath. "Peace on earth and good will among men." Why don't we have peace on earth? What brings peace to our hearts in the midst of a troubled world?

Sing "Silent Night" and then close with prayer thanking God for the peace we have in our hearts and praying for peace in a troubled world.



THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT - JOY Scripture: Matthew 2: 10

Advent is during the darkest time of the year. Some people do not like winter because it gets dark so early in the evenings. If it is night time turn out the lights for just a little bit then light a candle or two candles on the Advent Wreath. Ask: Why don't we like the darkness? How is spiritual darkness similar to the darkness of night? In what ways does Jesus bring light and joy to our lives?

Sing "This Little Light of Mine" and a Christmas Carol and close with prayer.



FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT - LOVE *Scripture: John 3:16*

Light a candle or light four candles on the Advent Wreath. Ask: What is one of the best gifts any family member or friend has ever given to you and why? Why was the gift given to you? Today we celebrate God's love for us which caused Him to give us His best gift . . . His Son. Why is that His best gift? What does that gift mean for each one of us if we accept it?

Sing one or more Christmas Carols and close with prayer.



CHRISTMAS - JESUS Scripture: John 6:68-69

Light a candle to symbolize Christ or light all the candles on the Advent Wreath lighting the center "Christ" candle last. Sing a Carol. Ask: What has been the most meaningful experience for you this Advent and Christmas Season If a child mentions a gift discuss how gifts symbolize the gift of Christ. Why is Christ the most valuable gift of all the Christmas gifts we receive in Christmas wrappings?

Sing some Carols and notice their mention of Hope, Joy, Peace, Love, and Jesus. Be thankful in your heart that Christmas is real to you and celebrate together in some form of prayer.


Christmas at De Soto Baptist Church






