




The mission of AB Boys is to disciple the younger men of the church to be disciples of Jesus. We aim to do this by eating together, praying together, studying scripture together, and playing together.

Children will have these lessons taught in a variety of ways and reinforced at every activity center they visit. The Bible Stories, Bible Points, and Bible Verses will be shared at every stop: Bible Discovery, Savanna Games, Safari Treats, KidVid Cinema, Imagination Station, the Veld Music Station, and at the SING & PLAY OPENING and FINALE.

Children ages 5-12 are divided into small "mini crews" of 4-5 children. Three "Mini crews" will make up the "Main Crews" that are led by adults. Either adults or teen/junior leaders will be in charge of the "mini crews" so that the children have one special person who knows them by name and works just with them. They will rotate from one station to the next throughout the afternoon. Children ages 4-5 (who have not yet attended Kindergarten) will be in the Pre-K class, led by a Certified Pre-K teacher and many youth helpers. They will rotate through the stations as well.

Each year we choose a service project of some kind for our children to learn about and be the recipient of their daily offerings. This year we will be supporting two of our American Baptist African Missions: Burundi, where we will be raising money to purchase goats to provide food and income for families there, and South Africa where we will be using our donations to purchase chickens for the same goal. We hope to have visits from some De Soto goats and chickens so that the children can learn of their great value, particularly in poverty-stricken areas.
