



Have you ever been to the desert?

The dictionary has various definitions of a desert:

1. A region so arid because of little rainfall that it supports only sparse and widely spaced vegetation or no vegetation at all;

2. Any area in which few forms of life can exist because of lack of water, permanent frost, or absence of soil;

3. Any place lacking in something

It seems God often uses deserts in the lives of His people. He does this because He knows the benefit of removing the distractions so you can rely more closely on Him.

When He rescued the Israelites out of Egypt to bring them into Relationship with Him, He took them to the desert; When Jesus was to begin His ministry, to fully teach His flesh obedience, He took Him to the desert;

Deserts can be uncomfortable and dreaded places but they can also be the best of places to draw close to God. To be alone with Him. To meditate on His word. To try to figure out your relationship with Him and what He would like to do in and through you. To discover yourself in Jesus.

Sometimes a church can become a desert place spiritually. Older members age in place and drop out of the church work force. Younger leaders who are mobile pick up and move away. During a pastor search, we realize the shepherd is not there to lead us. The teacher is not there to teach us. The spiritual structure we rested on is absent from our midst. We find we have become complacent relying on others to give us our spiritual food and tell us how to walk our Christian walk.

And so God leads us to a desert place. He does not desert us there, but He leads us there and calls us to draw aside and spend time with Him.

Paul could have gone to Jerusalem and spent time with the Apostles to build up his new faith. Instead, he went to the desert and spent time alone with God and the scriptures.

Do you feel a little lost? Do you feel like things are not in control? Do you feel a little more anxious and you just don't know why? Open your Bible seek to know God more intimately.

There is a wonderful bit of comfort in 1 John 2:27:

"As for you, the anointing you received from Him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as His anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in Him."

He will draw near to you and reveal to you a personal purpose in the desert place.






