

"O come, let us sing unto the Lord: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving" Psalm 95:1–2





In a BBC news article this week, Philippe Lazzarini, the UNRWA commissioner-general, stated, "I have sometimes the impression that the world is now losing its humanity."

UNRWA is the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East. Mr. Lazzarini's comments are based on the recent conflict in Israel and the inhumane treatment that the people groups involved are showing to one another, especially the non-combatant population.

"Humanity as a character trait is defined by "the quality of being humane; kindness; benevolence".

It's the way that we hope to be treated and to treat those around us. I wonder if those who have stepped back from being humane ever thought they could be driven to cross that line in which they walk away from their humanity, to treat another person inhumanely, due to the acts of atrocity and hatred brought to their doorstep.

Would you cross that line?

But I'm a Christian. I serve Jesus.

Do you think that will be enough?

Below the surface of my Christianity there is a sinful nature that would fight and claw its way to the surface. It is the old self of Colossians 3 which has been "put off" and replaced with the "new man which is renewed in knowledge…"

But we cannot be "renewed in knowledge" if we have no knowledge. If we remain babes in Christ, because we do not pursue the knowledge of Christ, we will find ourselves weak and continually letting that "old man" rise to the surface. I believe that is why God gives us so many commands here in this chapter to strive to be infused with Christ. He says "keep seeking", "set your minds", "rid yourselves", "put on".

And a most important command: "Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you..." There is only one way to do that. You must spend time engaged with it. Read it. Study it.

When those around me are losing their composure, or their neighborliness, or even their humanity, I want to rise above my sinful human nature and reflect Jesus into the midst of the situation. That takes a greater strength than I have on my own. I need to be filled with, infused with Jesus.

If we become complacent in our relationship and knowledge of Him, we will be no different than others who "lose their humanity". I fear we will fail Him when the world comes knocking at our door.

Start again today. Get engaged. Stay engaged. Seek others to study with. Hold each other accountable.

Fellowship and accountability centered around God's word helps us to be a light when it is needed.

THUS BEGAN A WEEK OF MUCH FUN, LAUGHTER, TEAS-ING, WONDERFUL MEALS, EXCURSIONS-WEST POINT, FDR'S FAMILY HOME, OTHER MANSIONS, APPLE ORCHARD FARM AND OUR LOVE FOR JESUS. THE VERY FIRST MEAL, I ASKED IF THEY WOULD LIKE TO JOIN US AS WE BLESSED THE FOOD, YES, THAT WAS FINE AND WE CONTINUES EVERY MEAL AFTER. There will be a sign-up at church to help in the different areas.




