I saw a lady at the Dollar Store this morning and her t-shirt said, "I'm done peopling for today." It made me laugh for there are days when we would all agree.

And then there's the example of the Apostle Paul. In Philippians 2:17 he speaks of service: "But even if I am being poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I rejoice and share my joy with you all."

A drink offering. And offering of liquid poured out on the fiery altar or perhaps on the ground. Either way a liquid that is poured out and simply disappears with no evidence it was ever there. That is what I picture Paul saying. It may seem insignificant and ineffectual at the time, but in some way, God makes use of it.

For whatever God needs of you.


